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The Erasmus Frankfurter Stadtschule is an all-day school. Through small classes, and individual support/tuition we aim to help each pupil finish school with the best possible set of final exam results. Thus it is Erasmus Frankfurter Stadtschule goalto individually encourage our pupils to achieve a wellfounded, all round education and gain the important qualifications that they need. We place a great emphasis upon our Europe identity and firmly ground this in the pupils' syllabus. Compulsory participation in a two-way exchange program with a foreign school and similar projects form a significant part of our educational ethos. Training in the use of multimedia and the development of our pupils' foreign language skills are integral to a comprehensive education. Therefore: • Foreign language lessons begin with English and Spanish lessons for Grade 5. • , and from Grade 9 a third, foreign language from the variety of languages we offer. (French, Italian, Latin, Russian, Chinese) Erasmus Frankfurter Stadtschule provides pupils with the opportunity to benefit from bilingual lessons. This means that starting early in Grade 5 one subject is taught in English or Spanish. Our pupils are led to develop their sense of responsibility towards the work that they do, and where possible choose their own tasks and projects, whilst small groups and a dedicated teaching staff foster a constructive learning atmosphere. The Erasmus Frankfurter Stadtschule is a general secondary school, focussing on general education: our students are between 10 and 20 years old, studying towards their highschool degree which provides them with the admission to university education. The school is a private day school where the majority of students commute on a daily basis to school. We don't have many students being in a disadvantaged area, have a migration background or are refugees. We would like to profit from the experience of schools in countries affected by recent migration developments from all over the world and with the aim that our students gain a different perspective and expand their horizon. We expect the partnership to provide both teachers and students with the chance to mix with other people from the European community and therefore broaden their minds and enrich their experience as active European citizens. The headmistress and a team of experienced teachers is in charge of running the project. In case these persons leave their posts in the future, other teachers who already collected experience with former COMENIUS projects and students exchanges will secure the realization of the current project.

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The Institute of Higher Education "LICEI Canudo-Marone ITI Galileo Galilei" is the result of a sizing operation that saw the merging of the two High school (Scientific and Classical) with the Industrial Technical Institute, determining the creation of a training and cultural hub for a vast territory. The school community involves 136 teachers and 1059 students attending the different courses: Classical High School, Scientific high school, and Technical Institute. Some of the subjects are common in the three courses, such as Italian, Maths, History, Science, others, like Greek, Latin, Physics, Chemistry, Mechatronics, Informatics and Electrotechnics are different according to the course chosen The perspective of internationalization of the Institute having new dimensions demands new training opportunities arising from the need to implement the culture of team working among people and contexts, with different cultural backgrounds. The European experiences realized by the two mentioned high schools (Comenius Projects, In-service Training, Erasmus Plus KA1e 3, Erasmus KA2, PON Projects for the raising of the students key competences, the realization of Language Internships abroad) merge with those activated by ITI (Erasmus K2, professional internship abroad, PON projects for the inclusion and promotion of European citizenship skills), in the prospect of the teachers cultural and professional growth and THE promotion of European citizenship skills OF the entire school and territorial community. The teachers involved in the above mentioned European projects, form a team of four people with interchanging roles. They have also designed the project PON (National Operational Plan) whose activities are shortly starting with the partnership of the international organization EUROPE DIRECT. These teachers have felt and shared the need for renewal of their teaching methods, to make them more adherent to a constantly evolving society, not to mention the theatrical workshops which have been realizing for years with the partnership of ROSSINI THEATRE in Gioia del Colle and the Internship courses. Moreover, the creation of CLIL paths has determined the need of the knowledge of the English foreign language even in nonlinguistic contents, so that students can acquire the skill of critical learning and autonomy in the creation of their own culture, as well as a correct formalization of written and oral thought. The staff participating in the designing activities, is engaged in the knowledge and use of new methods aiming at the modernization and internationalization of the Institute. The skills and previous experience of the staff will create interpersonal relationships based on cooperation and dialogue; furthermore, students will be promoted with: • autonomy in designing choices; • consolidation of their cultural tools; • improving their decisional and relational skills; • managing information materials and sources.

Our town Vodňany is located in the South of Bohemia, in the Czech Republic. It's a former royal town, famous for its fishing tradition, with a big amount of ponds in the surroundings. In Vodňany is situated the only Secondary Fishery School and Higher specialized school of water management and ecology in the Czech Republic. Our school is a secondary grammar school providing general education for our students. The school was established in 1994 and in 2016 united with two elementary schools in our town. There are 47 classes and about 1.000 learners altogether. Lots of them commute from surrounding villages and towns, because we are the main school in our area. Also our timetables are prepared depending on bus and train timetables to be convenient for commuters. At our grammar school there are 8 classes, about 170 students. The pedagogical staff includes 15 teachers. The students are taught classical subjects such as Geography, Biology, Chemistry, History, ICT, Maths, Physics, Civics, P.E or optional R.E. The students learn three languages, English and German are compulsory, Russian is optional. There are also specialized classrooms - an ICT classroom, a science laboratory and a language laboratory. A half of the classrooms is also equipped with tablets for all pupils in the class. The students also take part in many various activities organized by our school every year, e.g. biological courses, sport courses (skiing, water rafting, cycling, ...), charity events, students' days, thematic days and workshops. There are organized a lot of trips and exchange programmes for them to visit foreign countries. Our school is also involved in EUREGIO-projects, which means that students go to Germany and attend lessons there for eight months. Our activities We are the school giving students the opportunity to connect to others, we try to set up online collaboration projects with other schools, e.g. eTwinning that helps to improve not only the digital and language skills but also cooperation, initiative and crosscultural understanding. We have done some eTwinning projects recently, this year we have been working on five eTwinning projects, there was also an exchange staying in Slovenia, we created our own project webpage and did many activities with our students. Digital technology, the Internet and cloud computing can facilitate innovative ways of learning. It is important to give pupils competences such as collaboration, critical thinking and creativity. We are integrating virtual reality and QR codes in our lessons, to bring popular technologies into our lessons. We also teach IT in a newly equipped room and everything is aimed to provide wide range of information from different branches. We have invited native speaking teachers in the previous years and we organize a lot of talks with interesting people on interesting topics (places, people, traditions, history, etc.).

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We live in Csongrad which is a beautiful small town in the south-east of Hungary. It is famous for its beautiful rivers and its delicious wine. Our school's official name is Csongrádi Batsányi János Gimnázium és Kollégium or Janos Batsanyi Secondary Grammar School of Csongrad in English. 450 students study here in 24 classes and 54 teachers teach them from Monday to Friday. The students have six or seven lessons per day and they study general subjects and special ones, as well. The secondary grammar school education has been the basic profile of our institution from the beginnings and it has been developed with various trainings for many years. In 2017 our last technical class had its leaving exam, so since that time we have run only grammar classes. Currently we offer four-year grammar and science classes as well as an eight-year form. In our grammar classes, students can learn history, Hungarian grammar and literature, creative writing, drama and two foreign languages in a higher number. In our tourism classes, students have the opportunity to learn economics as a general subject. Apart from that, gastronomy, hotel accomodation education, catering and tourism can be learnt. In our science classes, students can choose from courses of mathematics-physics, biology-chemistry to geography-Information Technology. Our students can perform experiments connected with the above-mentioned subjects and computer system analysis in the very modern student laboratory. Several members of the staff took their leaving exams in this school, so we pass on the torch to our students in many cases, we develop the talent spotter's work of our formers or we open towards new fields. We encourage our students to take part in competitions, our collegues not only give a hand with their prepartion, but also they take part in attempts with exemplary behaviour. We claim that language teaching in our school is very important. Our students can choose from English or German as their first target language, if they are specialized in Art subject they learn it in 5 hours a week, if in Science subjects they learn it in 3 hours a week. They can choose these two languages as second languages, in addition to this Latin and French are also optional. The second languge is taught in every class in 3 hours, so in this way we make it possible for them to reach the exam level in every Besides teaching the so called general knowledge subjects we also find sport and cultural education important from the point of view of our students' personality development and cultural awareness in order to be able to recognize the fact that only those people can be successful in the different social - economical areas of life who can constantly renew their personalities mentally, emotionally, physically and live in harmony not just with their outside world but also with themselves.

We will enable this for pupils, teachers and steakholder of this project. Together creating video clips and emissions about common themes should give the opportunity in learning and teaching in an amusing touch, new ways and open frame, related to the needs of the participants. Bringing outputs like a community where it's possible to share ideas, reflexions, stories and poems, sounds and music of different countries and regions will be a tool for more cooperation. But beyond that opens the way to reach more people with the ideas and outcomes of this common work. The main objectives of the project "ABE" Acting for a Better Europe is to help the students first to understand themselves and their own cultural barriers in order to be able to overcome them and become bettoer EU citizens. Through acting the students will open themselves up to understand the other cultures and realize the need for a common European identity, the need to create common agreement for more saftey, to increase the European position in the worldwide global economic system, to create a common statement in topics as environment, clima protection and migration. 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#### Description of the activity:

- How is it going to be related to or integrated with the normal activities of the involved schools?

The focus of the project meeting in Hungary will be advertising and dissemination. During the week the students will create questionnaires assessing the awarness being European in the beginning and the end of the project. 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## Follow Up

How are you going to assess if the project's objectives have been met?

The evaluation will foresee both quantitative and qualitative moments.

In the first ones will be highlighted:

- the number of students and teachers involved in the project,
- the number of mobilities carried out,
- the members of the Etwinning platform

The qualitative aspects will be determined by the answers to the customer satisfaction and questionnaires ex ante, in progress and in the final part. Teachers will evaluate whether the activities have met the expectations, if the project has had an impact on the teaching practice, if the awareness of European citizenship, meant as the sharing of historical and cultural values, has undergone a positive change.

In ex ante customer satisfaction questionnaires, participants will be asked if the information on the objectives and activities of the project are clear, sufficient and complete. Students will explain the reasons for the choice to participate in the project, specifying if they are determined by the need to live a useful experience, by the desire to meet new people, by the need to improve language skills or the ability to work in European contexts.

In itinere students will be asked to fill out the customer satisfaction questionnaire on the activities proposed during the mobility, or if the activities have been interesting and congruent with the objectives set and if the students recommend the experience to other comrades.

Students will be asked to provide any suggestions to improve the activities of the following mobilities of the project.

The ex-post customer satisfaction questionnaire addressed to students will determine whether participation in the Erasmus program has met the needs presented in the ex-ante questionnaire. Questionnaires will also be given to teachers to see if their participation in the project has led to changes in their teaching practice and curriculum and to the teachers of the students 'classes to evaluate the impact of the Erasmus project on students' learning, on the approach to the disciplines and their motivational repercussions.

The data collected will be at the school community disposal for sharing and dissemination of the work done. Furthermore, in the ex post customer satisfaction questionnaires, questions will also be asked about the impact of the activities on the Europeanization process of the Institute.

The report will be included in the school website in the part related to the project within the Erasmus Section.

Finally, it would be appropriate to record the results at a distance to see if the stimuli received allowed students to take on the role of a European citizen with greater awareness and a global vision of economic, social and political problems, overcoming harmful forms of individualism.

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How will the participation in this project contribute to the development of the involved schools in the long-term? Do you have plans to continue using the results of the project or continue to implement some of the activities after the project's end?

The project will allow the school and local community to realize:

- •the awareness of the status of Citizen of the European Union,
- •the knowledge of Europe as an instrument of social cohesion and growth,
- the implementation of the European citizenship skills,
- the innovation of the teaching methods of the discipline of Citizenship and Constitution,
- the creation of a dossier of good practices for the promotion of the culture of sharing,
- the enrichment and innovation of teaching courses with repercussions on students,
- •the increasing of students' motivation through their involvement in innovative and international paths.

The experiences acquired by students and teachers will represent an important step of their cultural growth not only in the area where the institute is located, but also in the neighboring towns.

A deep reflection on the relationship between local policies and European directives will be the consequence of the outcomes of the activities and of the historical and political analysis carried out by the students and teachers tutors and later shared with the school community, .

The project staff and teachers tutors will collect data on the adopted methodology that will foster the laboratory dimension and will share them in the relevant departments.

The linguistic and argumentative skills which are fundamental in managing a verbal and written communicative interaction in national and international contexts will also be enhanced.

This experience will implement soft skills such as:

- acting autonomously and responsibly,
- collaboration and participation,
- interacting with others, understanding their different points of view and enhancing their own and others' abilities,
- contributing to common learning.

Students will be involved in the presentation activities of the Institute and of the territory thanks to the collaboration between school, municipal administration and local and regional cultural associations. Participating pupils will also become tutors of classmates with linguistic difficulties, due to weak learning or recent immigration, thanks to the ability of analyzing the surrounding environment, identifying adequate resources, developing solutions.
